



## MAKE YOUR OWN MINI GARDEN!

Have you ever heard of a terrarium?

Basically a terrarium is a tiny garden in a clear container you can see through.

If your terrarium is left open the environment will be drier. Plants like cactus and succulents will love this.

If your container is closed it will hold more humidity – like a mini rainforest! Try ferns and begonias if you're going to put a lid on your terrarium.



Ok, let's get started!

1. Choose your container - a fish bowl, a vase, a plastic container.
2. In this order, layer some small rocks, some activated charcoal and some potting soil. Ask mum and dad for help with these ingredients.
3. Place your plants and any extra decorations in the potting soil.
4. Water your terrarium once a week. Don't over water it, and keep it in a bright spot, but away from direct sunlight.
