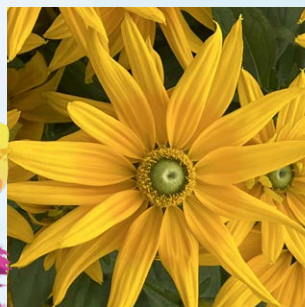
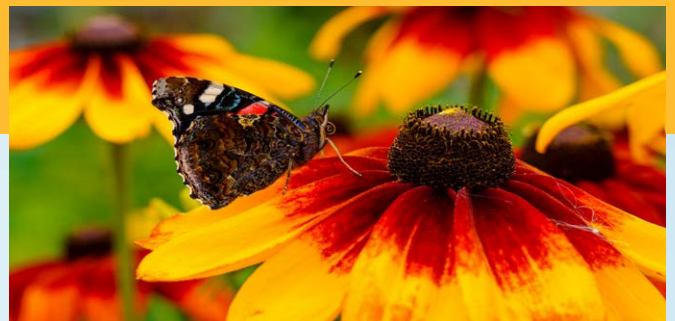
Welcome to Spring

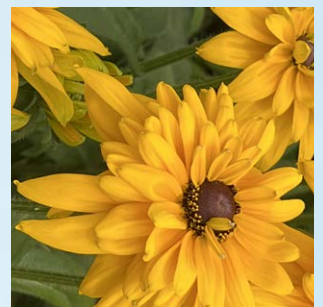

NEW Rudbeckia Sunbeckia

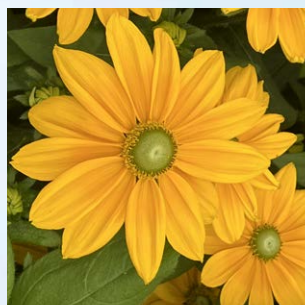

ROSEMARY

The fragrant, evergreen leaves are extremely high in iron, calcium and Vitamin B6. Finely chop leaves and use to flavour lamb, fish, vegetables, soups, stews and biscuits.

BASIL SWEET

Sweet, spicy clove flavoured herb that can be used fresh or dried. Use with tomato dishes, pesto, vinegars, cheese, chicken, eggs, fish, marinades, pasta, salads and butters.

PARSLEY ITALIAN

With a stronger sweeter flavour than normal curled parsley, Italian Parsley is a versatile herb that can be used with stews, stocks, sauces, salad, pasta, stuffing, and as a garnish.

'GROSSE LISSE'

A full flavoured tomato that ripens midway through the season on a large, robust plant.



'TIGERELLA'

This variety produces delicious 5cm round red-yellow striped tomatoes with superb flavour.



'LEMONDROP'

An unusual yellow cherry tomato, that grows well in cold, wet weather and ripens over an extended season.



'MORTGAGELIFTER'

A popular variety which forms large heads and sides shoots can be picked for up to three months.



'PRINCIPEBORGHESE'

This dwarf variety has a low sugar, seed and moisture content making it good for preserving and sauces.



'TOMMY TOE'

Produces sweet 3cm fruits held in a truss of 7-9, fruits 10 weeks from transplant, 11kg per plant.



'BEAMS YELLOW PEAR'

Golden yellow pear-shaped fruits with a healthy shiny skin and firm flesh, this yellow cherry preserves well.



'REDFIG'

The red sibling to 'Beam's Yellow Pear' takes its name from the similarly-shaped long neck and fig-shaped form.



'CHERRY ROMA'

A sweet and spicy tomato which produces a mass of mini roma-shaped fruits throughout the season.



'BLACK CHERRY'

Named for their dark, juicy flesh, these tomatoes produce exceptionally sweet fruit.



'BLUEBERRIES'

Catches the eye at all stages of development, this tomato is red when ripe in the shade or deep purple-black in the sun.

Grapes

Red Globe, Menindee Seedless, White Muscat and Black Muscat are available from September each year, perfect for Spring planting.

When considering the best position to plant grapes, think of the Italian hillsides. Grapes love full sun all day and it's really important to have well-drained soil that is free of weeds. Grapes grow best on a vertical trellis or arbour and look very effective hanging down from above – it makes picking them easier too!

The most important thing to do for grapes is quality pruning. While it feels severe at the time, grapes benefit from heavy cutting back during their dormancy. Using quality secateurs, cut the branches back to where the buds begin. These will begin to produce several shoots which will then grow leaves and flowers, and in turn fruit.

It's important to thin out the fruit if the vines are over-producing to ensure higher quality fruit. Remove any flower clusters that look oddly shaped and any fruit that is poorly developed.

The hardest part is to not be too eager to harvest your fruit. Grapes will not continue to ripen once they are picked from the vine, so test the fruit every couple of days until it is fully ripe and then harvest your bunches.

Whether you are eating them as table grapes, using them for jams and jellies or attempting your own wine production, growing grapes in your garden is lots of fun and very rewarding.

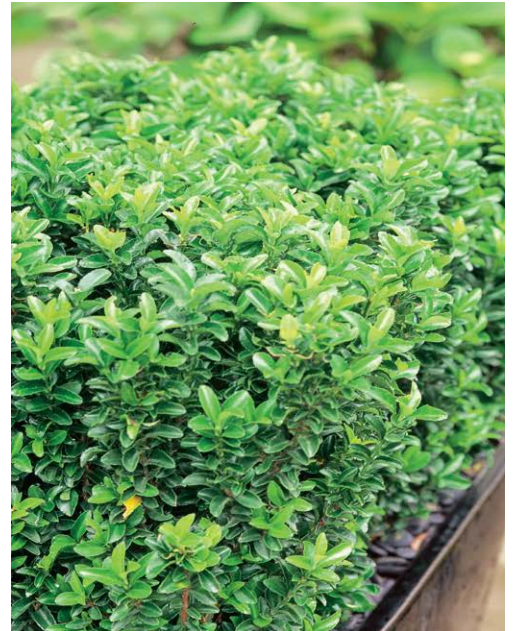

Fast growing, tall shrub with glossy foliage and coppery-gold new growth. Forms an ideal narrow, dense screen.

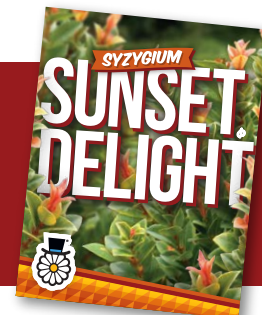


Select

The new growth is a standout feature with extremely vibrant orange tips appearing on bright green foliage.

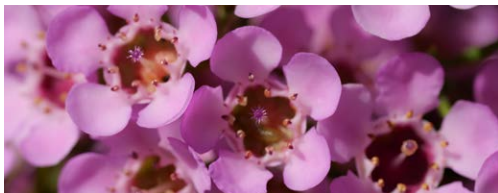

Calathea

White Fusion

This popular houseplant makes a striking statement! Characterised by the unique showy green, light green and white marbled variegation with purple underside, which adds depth to this beautiful plant. Loves humidity and low light. It may take some extra care, but the rewards are well worth it. Grows 30-50cm and is clumping in nature.



Dracaena

Marley

A very attractive indoor or shade plant with bright green-yellow striped foliage. Displays a rosette habit and is a great addition to the home as a low maintenance house plant.





Asplenium Hurricane

This unique birds nest fern will have you in a spin. Its wavy foliage grows in a whirlwind habit which makes a great impact. Easy to care for and it is the perfect statement plant in the bathroom and can be placed into the garden as a feature plant as it gets larger.



Pothos Devil's Ivy

Also known as Pothos Green and Gold, due to the yellow/gold flecks adorning the predominantly green leaves, this is one of the more popular pothos plants. A hardy trailing vine, it can withstand drying out for periods. Suited to hanging baskets, trailing walls and climbing totems.



Spathiphyllum Romano

Lush and hardy, this spathiphyllum makes a great addition to any home or shady garden. Boasting vivid green leaves and long-lasting white flowers, these stunning plants prefer medium light and are perfect for growing in pots inside or containers on balconies.



Hedera Camouflage

Small to medium lobe shaped leaves with heart shaped base. Highly variegated with a unique camouflage pattern. Great for hanging baskets or green wall addition.

Rabbits Foot
