

TOP TIPS FOR HEIRLOOM SEEDLING SUCCESS

1. Prepare your soil

Get your soil ready by weeding and digging over, preferably incorporating some well-rotted compost and aged manure.

2. Water seedlings prior to planting

Water your seedling punnets well at least 30 minutes prior to planting to help reduce transplant shock. Use a diluted seaweed solution if possible.

3. Be careful with roots and stems

Turn the punnet over, being careful to support the seedlings. Gently squeeze the sides to dislodge the potting mix and remove. Carefully separate the seedlings.

4. Plant in a prepared hole

Try to minimise root disturbance. Plant at the same height or just a fraction deeper than the seedlings were in their punnet.

5. Water well

Firm the soil down around seedlings to help secure them in the ground. Water the soil. Stake climbing or tall varieties if necessary.

6. Protect

Seedlings are prone to attack from snails and slugs. Use pet-safe snail pellets or beer traps to protect them during establishment.




CAULIFLOWER MEDLEY MIX

An Australian native shrub prized for its unique, dark-purple foliage resembling a starry night sky. Clusters of bright, star-like pink flowers contrast against the dark backdrop, creating a visually striking effect. This compact and hardy evergreen is well-suited for gardens and provides year-round ornamental appeal.



Burgundy Queen


Little Poly
